Staff Expectations

Staff Dress

You must wear the provided camp staff shirt (in good, clean condition) along with black bottom while on duty. Shirts will be distributed on the day of counselor orientation. You must wear athletic shoes, NO SANDALS, NO CROCS. Shorts must be modest in length. <u>No outerwear</u> is to be worn over the camp shirt while campers are present.

Staff training will be held from June 9-13, 9am-3pm each day. These are paid trainings. After camp begins, we will have a weekly staff meeting. Attendance at these meetings is mandatory for all staff.
